



Lammack Results - End of KS2 Results (Year 6) Summer 2016

Children in Year 6 took part in new testing and assessment arrangements in 2016. Pupils' knowledge and understanding of the new curriculum was assessed. This curriculum provides greater challenge with higher expectations set for the end of KS2.

The results of the SATs (tests) are reported using a scaled score, where a score of 100 represents the expected standard, and a scaled score of 110 - 120 means that a child is working at a higher level of attainment. The highest possible score is 120 and the lowest is 80.

Children were awarded one of the following Teacher Assessment judgements in writing:

Expected Standard: Working at the expected standard for a child at the end of Year 6.

Greater Depth: Working at greater depth within the expected standard, with a strong understanding of the curriculum.

Interpreting the Progress Scores:

- A **score of 0** means pupils in this school on average do about **as well** at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A **positive score** means pupils in this school on average do **better** at KS2 than those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A **negative score** means pupils in this school on average do **worse** at KS2 than those with similar prior attainment nationally.

Lammack Results – End of KS1 (Year 2) Summer 2016

This is the first year of the new testing and assessment arrangements for Year 2. These arrangements reflect the more challenging National Curriculum which was introduced in 2014. The system of national curriculum levels has been removed and the new measures are as follows:

Expected Standard: Working at the expected standard for a child at the end of Year 2.

Greater Depth: Working at greater depth within the expected standard, with a strong understanding of the curriculum.

In Year 1, children take part in the Phonics Screening Check. The table below shows you the percentage of children who passed at Lammack compared to the national figure. **From this result Lammack was identified as being in the top 8% of schools in the country for its phonics.**
