Year 5 Topic Launch



On Tuesday, Year 5 had a thrilling and educational day around their topic, "I'm An Evacuee, Get Me Out of Here!" The students arrived at school dressed as World War II evacuees and created evacuation tags to add to the experience. As soon as they got to the hall, a steam train was waiting to evacuate them to their destination for the day.

In the classroom, the students explored replica artefacts from World War II, gaining a deeper understanding of the period. They also studied Anderson shelters and had the opportunity to build their own, complete with creative touches such as miniature beds and even a wireless.

To further immerse themselves in the experience, the children produced their news reports in the style of "Newsround" about the Declaration of War. They wrote, recorded, and edited the films themselves, demonstrating their new found knowledge and creativity.

As a capstone to the day, the class listened to music from the time and watched vintage Pathe films, bringing the past to life and providing a glimpse into the world of wartime Britain. Overall, it was a highly memorable and informative day that the Year 5 students will surely not forget!

Year 3 Educational Visit

On Monday and Tuesday, 3A and 3HA visited Martin Mere as part of their 'Vicious Vikings' topic launch. They took part in a range of activities throughout the day which they all thoroughly enjoyed.
